## ● **HISTORY OF CHARUCHANDRA COLLEGE**

- Charuchandra College has been christened after Late Charuchandra Chattopadhyay, a notable Indian nationalist. It has its history embedded in the country's post-partition scenario, when Dr. Satyendra Nath Roy and some other eminent academicians of Dacca University and its affiliated colleges initiated a move to establish a College in South Calcutta, to cater to the needs of migrant refugees from erstwhile East Pakistan.
- The family members of Late Charuchandra Chattopadhyay, following Charuchandra's spirit of social work, came forward to assist in this noble task. The College was founded on 1st October 1947, with Dr. S.N.Ray as the first Principal and was housed in its present premise at 22 Lake Road, Kolkata – 700 029.
- The abiding motto of Charuchandra College is ALTIORAPETO – I SEEK HIGHER LIFE. This motto is conceived not merely in rhetorical terms that reiterate a zealous spirit, but real-life manoeuvres, aimed at the all-round physical and mental growth of students, by mingling knowledge of science with society.

# COLLEGE RULES

- Once admitted a student is expected to conduct himself /herself in a manner that upholds the dignity and honour of the institution and refrain from causing any damage to other person or property. Students are liable to face strict disciplinary action for disobedience , misconduct, misbehaviour or for any act of indiscipline. Students must take proper care of all the college property. Any damage done to the property of the college by disfiguring walls, doors, windows, fittings, furniture and such other things is breach of discipline and will be considered a punishable offence.
- **Attendance:**
  - Students must attend Lectures / Tutorials/ Practical regularly. Defaulters may face Disciplinary Action. Throughout each academic session class attendance in individual subjects is strictly monitored. On the basis of attendance alone, students could be debarred from appearing in internal examinations.
  - University regulations stipulate that to be considered collegiate a student must attend at least 75% of classes held in each subject. If the student has attended between 60% and 75% of classes in each subject he/she is considered non-collegiate and becomes discollegiate if the percentage of attendance falls below 60 and is debarred from appearing at college and University examinations.
- **Payment of Fees:**
  - All fees, except library fines must be paid on time.
  - Tuition fees must be paid before the fifteenth of each month. A fine of Rs.10 per month is levied for defaulters.
  - Fees for admission are to be paid before the scheduled date in order to have names enrolled in class registers.
  - Rs.25/- is charged for a duplicate identity Card and Rs.20/- for duplicate Fees Book.
  - All dues (regarding fees, library books etc} must be cleared before commencement of examinations.
  - Refund of caution money, with appropriate deduction for damages, will be available after completion of the course and within a specified date, failing which the amount is likely to be forfeited.
- **Rules Regarding Transfer:**
  - According to University norms.



# CODE OF CONDUCT

- Students are expected to maintain the highest standards of discipline and dignified manner of behaviour inside as well as outside the College campus. They shall abide by the rules and regulations of the College and should act in a way that highlights the discipline and esteem of the College.
- The student shall be regular and sincere about his/her studies.
- Students must uphold academic integrity, respect all persons and their rights and property and safety of others.
- Students must refrain from mishandling and tampering with library books or college computer systems.
- Use of Mobile Phone during class hours is prohibited and is liable for punishment.

- Smoking, chewing and spitting tobacco products or pan masala, consumption of alcohol or narcotic drugs is strictly prohibited inside the college premises. Violation of this rule will invite disciplinary action.

- Applicants can register only once in the admission portal for this institution. On successful completion of registration a unique 10 digit application number is generated, which the applicant receives in SMS and Email if provided, along with his/her chosen password.
- The system checks whether an applicant is unique from the following data - Name, Roll No. (10 + 2) , Mobile No. and e-mailid
- Applicant is responsible to provide correct information/data, to the best of his/her knowledge, while filling up the online form and in the process if it is found that there is any discrepancy, then his/her application is liable to be cancelled.
- After confirmation any candidate will not able to modify any information
- After confirmation of the registration the candidate can take a printout of the Application Form. Please note that after publication of provisional merit list no modification of data is allowed at the applicant end.
- It is mandatory/compulsory for a candidate to provide his/her personal mobile number and emailid which may be used to send various information during the process of admission.
- To apply for new subject/s after confirming the application, a candidate needs to login using his/her registration ID and password and click the link 'apply more subjects' and add new subject to the application.
- The verification of all the documents according to the declaration in the form submitted will be done only on the date of commencement of classes.
- Admission will be cancelled if the documents are found not in conformity with the declaration in the forms submitted.
- Applicants who are already registered under CU, should apply for that subject only in which s/he has registered previously.

# ADMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 After successful registration unique application number and password will be SMS & Email to you and will be redirected to a page where you will need to upload all necessary documents and then you will be allowed for course & subject selection of your preferences as per criteria
- 2 All admissions are provisional. The verification of all documents according to the declaration in form submitted will be done only on the date of commencement of classes. Admission will be cancelled if the documents are found not in conformity with the declaration in the forms submitted.
- 3. Candidates have to submit the hard copy of the application form and the self attested copies of the relevant documents during verification at the college.
- 4 For admission related information visit the college website regularly.
- 5 If you have already registered with the college, you click on EXISTING APPLICANT (green Colour) button where you need to provide your application number and password to continue.
- 6 If your entered 10+2 records match the admission criteria of your subject selection, it will be added to your list and you can then continue to add more subjects up to the maximum allowed subjects. After adding all the subjects of your choice and uploading the documents you need to click on the Payment button to make necessary payment for application.
- 7 Modification of information is allowed till provisional list is published. Application can be modified by Edit Application option
- 8 On successful application you will get a system generated Application Number and password which you have to mention for all future correspondences. With this Application Number and Password you can always login by clicking on Existing Applicant and will be able to browse and modify the information previously entered.
- 9 You need to register yourself first against the college by filling up the Application form.
- 10 Once you save the application you can always modify by logging in and clicking modify profile.
- 11 If course of studies is already selected and confirmed you can not modify certain information that may affect your admission criteria. In such case you need to cancel existing application using cancel application link and make a fresh application.

## • **Anti-Ragging Cell**

- Ragging is totally banned. Ragging means the following: any conduct, written or spoken, or any act in the nature of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other student; rowdy or indisciplined activity causing annoyance, hardship, psychological harm or fear in a fresher; asking students to do any act which will cause or generate a sense of shame or embarrassment or have adverse physical or psychological effect. Anyone found guilty of ragging and / or abetting ragging is liable to be punished. The anti ragging committee will determine the nature of gravity of the offence. Possible punishments can range from suspension from classes to rustication.

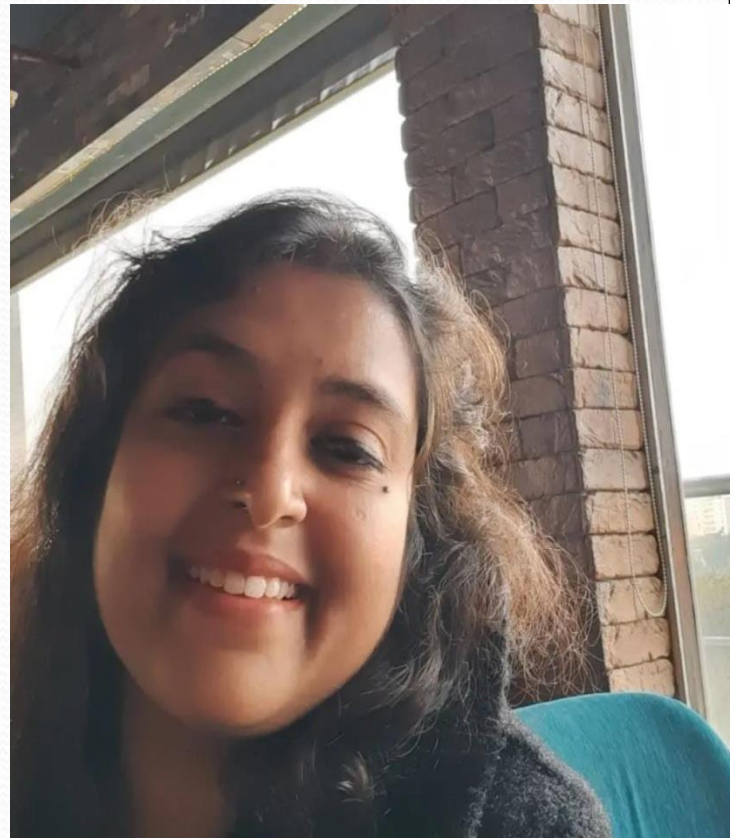


